

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS AND TIMELINES – **CSNN Vancouver Island Natural Nutrition Diploma Program**

TIMELINES: Students must complete the requirements listed below within the timelines or be subject to uparadina courses.

- One Year Program students are expected to finish all requirements within one year, but have a maximum of two years to complete the program.
- Two Year Program students are expected to finish all requirements within two years but have a maximum of three years to complete the program.
- Students who do not complete all of the requirements within the timelines will be subject to new requirements, including course upgrades and additional tuition fees. Students who break for 5 or more years from their studies will be required to redo the whole program.
